A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SAN LUIS OBISPO REGIONAL SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICS TEAM (REGIONAL SWAT TEAM)

WHEREAS, the Cities of Arroyo Grande, Grover Beach, Morro Bay, Paso Robles, Pismo Beach, San Luis Obispo, along with the California Polytechnic State University San Luis Obispo (Cal Poly) and California State Parks have operated a Regional SWAT Team under a previously signed written agreement; and

WHEREAS, the participating agencies chief law enforcement officers have reviewed and prepared a new Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) updating language in several sections, including but not limited to, the Purpose, Term, Agency Responsibilities, Agency Budgeting and Indemnification; and

WHEREAS, the MOU has been reviewed by legal counsel for each of the participating agencies and each counsel has approved the MOU as to form. A copy of the MOU is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and is incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Luis Obispo that the Chief of Police may sign and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the San Luis Obispo Police Department to participate in the San Luis Obispo Regional Special Weapons and Tactics Team (Regional SWAT Team).
