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**SUBJECT:** REVIEW OF THE 2024-25 HUMAN SERVICES GRANT MID-YEAR REPORTS

### RECOMMENDATION

Receive and file the 2024-25 Human Services Grant Mid-Year Reports and, if necessary, ask staff to follow up with recipients if issues, challenges, or concerns are identified in the reports.

### BACKGROUND

The 2024-25 Human Services Grant funding recommendations were approved by City Council on July 16, 2024. During the months of January, February, and March 2025, the Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) received mid-year reports from the 16 grantees and on March 5, 2025, the Human Relations Commission (HRC) assigned liaison roles for each grantee. As required in the contract signed by the grant recipients, a mid-year report is to be submitted to the Office of DEI detailing information on the first six (6) months of program implementation. The report must include any demographic information, a detailed financial report section explaining the use of funds thus far, and performance outcomes related to the scope of the services.

Each Commissioner will provide a summary of their respective assigned grant recipients' mid-year report and inform staff if the recipient is in compliance with the expected implementation of their proposed project and ask staff to follow up with recipients if issues, challenges, or concerns are identified.

Since the HRC has one new Commissioner who will be starting their tenure at the April 2, 2025, meeting, DEI Admin Specialist Samantha Vethavanam will review the mid-year reports for both Community Action Partnership San Luis Obispo (CAPSLO) programs and the Smart Share Housing Solutions program.
