A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A REVISED TEMPORARY EMPLOYEE SALARY SCHEDULE TO ADDRESS AN INCREASE TO MINIMUM WAGE

WHEREAS, California Senate Bill No. 3, Chapter 4, An Act to Amend Sections 245.5, 246, and 1182.12 of the Labor Code, signed into law on April 4, 2016, requires an annual increase in the minimum wage by the lesser of 3.5% or US CPI-W (the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics non-seasonally adjusted United States Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers), with the results rounded to the nearest \$0.10; and

WHEREAS, the State of California has determined that the minimum wage shall increase by 2.49 percent to \$16.90 per hour and shall be implemented for all employers by January 1, 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Luis Obispo as follows:

SECTION 1. The City agrees to amend the temporary job classification salary grades, as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto, effective January 1, 2026.
