

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2026 SERIES)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A SIDE LETTER TO THE JULY 1, 2025, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028, MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO AND THE SAN LUIS OBISPO CITY EMPLOYEES' ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2025 the City Council adopted Resolution # 11579 (2025 Series) ratifying the 2025-2028 Memorandum of Understanding between the City of San Luis Obispo and The San Luis Obispo City Employees' Association; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis Obispo and The San Luis Obispo City Employees' Association have agreed that employees in the group who are assigned to standby on designated holidays will receive \$75 per day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Luis Obispo as follows:

SECTION 1. The Side Letter to the July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2028, Memorandum of Understanding between the City of San Luis Obispo and The San Luis Obispo City Employees' Association, attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved by the Council. All other terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding remain as previously approved on June 17, 2025.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall file and furnish a copy of the resolution to Ryan Dale, President of The City of San Luis Obispo City Employees' Association, and Nickole Domini, Director of Human Resources.

SECTION 3. Amendments to compensation for The San Luis Obispo City Employees' Association do not constitute a "Project" under CEQA Guidelines Sec. 15378.
