A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA, RENAMING THE ANHOLM NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY AS THE CERRO SAN LUIS NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY

**WHEREAS,** on September 4, 2018, the City Council adopted the Anholm Bikeway Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** on February 5, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 10978 amending the name of the Anholm Bikeway Plan to be the Anholm Neighborhood Greenway; and

**WHEREAS,** on November 24, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 11191 to promote awareness and facilitate the ability of property owners throughout the city to remove racist covenants that may exist in their property deeds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis Obispo prioritizes the commitment to make San Luis Obispo a welcoming, inclusive, and safe community for everyone, and to promote free thought and speech, while condemning racism, hate speech, bigotry, violence, and prejudice; and

**WHEREAS**, the Anholm neighborhood historically included restrictive covenants limiting property ownership for non-white individuals; and

WHEREAS, the greenway route is along the base of Cerro San Luis Mountain; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cerro San Luis Mountain is one of the most prominent natural landmarks to San Luis Obispo; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of San Luis Obispo as that:

**SECTION 1.** The Anholm Neighborhood Greenway is now titled "Cerro San Luis Neighborhood Greenway."
