## RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_ (2022 SERIES)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022, DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

**WHEREAS**, a General Municipal Election was held in the City of San Luis Obispo on Tuesday, November 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California and City Charter for the holding of elections; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Resolution No. 11340 (2022 Series), the San Luis Obispo County Clerk-Recorder canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results, which are attached hereto and made a part herein as "Exhibit A."

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of San Luis Obispo as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the names of the persons voted for at the election for Mayor are as follows:

ERICA A. STEWART JEFFERY SPECHT RICHARD ORCUTT DONALD HEDRICK

**SECTION 2.** That the names of the persons voted for at the election for Member of City Council are as follows:

JOE BENSON EMILY FRANCIS MICHELLE SHORESMAN JAMES PAPP

**SECTION 3.** That the whole number of ballots cast, and the number of ballots cast for the above-named offices are listed in "Exhibit A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

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**SECTION 4**. That the City Council does declare and determine that: Erica A. Stewart was elected as Mayor for the full-term ending December 1, 2024; Michelle Shoresman was elected as Member of the City Council for a full-term ending December 1, 2026; Emily Francis was elected as Member of the City Council for a full-term ending December 1, 2026.

**SECTION 5**. The City Clerk shall enter into the records of the City of San Luis Obispo, a statement of the results of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person; and (5) The total number of votes given to each person.

**SECTION 6.** That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they were elected.
